Non-Capital Cases³:

Capital Cases:

For capital representations commenced, and capital appeals perfected on or after April 24, 1996, there is a waivable limit of \$7,500. The \$7,500 limit applies to the total payments for investigative, expert, and other services in a case, not to each service individually. (CJA Guidelines § 660.20.20)

²This category includes but is not limited to the following representations: Petty Offenses, Probation Violation; Supervised Release Hearing; Parole Proceedings Under Chapter 11 of Title 18, U.S.C.; Material Witness in Custody; Mental Condition Hearings Pursuant to Chapter 313 of Title 18, U.S.C., Civil or Criminal Contempt; Witness (both grand jury and court witnesses); International Extradition and Rule 35 motions; Crack Cocaine Retroactive Amendment Proceedings.

³The maximum with prior authorization applies separately for each service provider; the maximum without prior authorization applies for each category of service. These rates apply to work performed on or after January 1, 2016. The former case compensation maximums of \$2,400 and \$800 apply if the provider's work on the representation was completed before January 1, 2016.
