ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

The United States Attorney for the Eastern District of Arkansas has informed the Court that Congress has appropriated funds for that Office and that its Civil Division employees have resumed their duties. Accordingly, the stay of all civil cases to which the United States is a party is lifted.

The United States has also requested an extension of 35 days for all of its pending civil motions and cases, but this request is denied without prejudice. Instead, the United States should make individual extension requests to the judge to whom the motion or case is assigned.
